What are we looking for?



We are looking for **international students**, who have completed their **school education outside Germany** – and would be happy to tell other students, especially student teachers, of their education experiences.

What is the project about? - The context:



Germany's future teachers work in an increasingly globalised environment. Teachers must be able to place global developments and the consequences of this on society in context, on the basis of their own experience, and convey relevant content in a specialised, authentic manner. Future teachers should also be enabled to approach the issue of increasing international and cultural diversity at German schools.

International experience and intercultural knowledge help them to teach to the best of their ability. However, it is not always possible for all trainee teachers to spend some time abroad. Thus, it is important to provide **opportunities @home for international and intercultural exchange and communication with peers**, allowing for reflection and placing one's own teaching professionalisation processes in a global context.

What is the project objective?



This project will

- provide a **space for discourse on international education and exchange in English** (as lingua franca in international education)
- give future Bavarian teachers the opportunity to learn about international educational contexts through a personal lense @home
- foster intercultural awarness and transcultural competences by providing peer-to-peer encounters and opportunities for joint reflections

What do I have to do?



You will have to be willing to **share your own individual educational journey with fellow students** at Passau University, who are training to become teachers.

You will have to **illustrate your story with photos, prepare a presentation**, bring some music or any other item you like - and tell us about.

To sum up – please tell us about:

- the country you went to school in & the school system
- your **personal school experiences** good and bad and your personal journey which brought you to your current destination, Passau University

How much time do I have to invest?



- 60 minutes during the semester for: telling us your story, answering questions and discussing educational issues with your German peers
- 60 minutes for one initial group meeting (planning & scheduling)
- Some time to prepare your story and illustrate it (e.g. PowerPoint)
- Some time for a collaborative project & exhibition, showcasing your educational story (tbc)


Other requirements
