What is the project about?

Planned are: international delicacies & drinks, Christmas biscuits, music, dances and games, as colourful and intercultural as possible!

What do I have to do?



Together with a team of committee members, you will plan and organize the winter Christmas festival, from the preliminary planning to helping out on the day of the festival. It should be colorful and intercultural, and you are welcome to contribute your ideas to the project.

The team tasks include

- Preparation/acquisition of Christmas baked goods in cooperation with international university groups/students
- Organization of a supporting program (decorations, activities, music, dance)
- Co-operation with dance groups/ bands/ choir etc.
- Purchase/ preparation and distribution of soups during the event on 16.12.
- Decorating/ setting up and dismantling the festival/market on 16.12.
- Assistance during the event on 16.12.

How much time do I need to invest?



25.10.: AYCD kick-off to get to know the whole team (16:30, ITZ), distribution of tasks

from 28. 10: Weekly meetings for updating

Between meetings: teamwork in small groups (decorations, activities, advertising, dancing, etc.) Possibly joint craft evening.

Festival on 16.12.: There will be a shift plan in the period from approx. 12-23 o'clock

A total of about 35 hours in 7 weeks
