

What is the project about?

Exchange between students (young professionals) and immigrant specialists from the same subject area (if possible).

Who are we looking for? Students (or young professionals with 1-2 years of professional experience) as mentors.

Who are the mentees?

The mentees are **immigrant academics** who would like to work in their profession in Germany. They all have a university degree / professional experience in their country of origin and German language skills of at least level B1.
