What is the project about?



Global Juniors meet Golden Agers: the Generation café

The Generation Café is a regular meeting where **international students/guest researchers** and **senior citizens/locals** from the Passau region come together.

The aim is to promote **intercultural and intergenerational exchange** and create a sense of belonging. Here, both sides can learn from each other, support each other and discover new similarities. Whether conversations or activities - the café helps to become part of the community and experience social participation.

What do I have to do?



There are various task areas to choose from:

Intercultural event management: Logistics/ organization/ moderation of the meetings

- Coordination and communication with the event locations and participants
- Culturally and generationally sensitive support/ moderation of the two-week event
- If required, designing the program for the meetings (e.g. topics, activities).
- Researching and planning joint activities

Advertising and communication:

- Creation of flyers, posters and digital content for social media
- Creation of advertising texts/press releases for mailings
- Direct approach and recruitment of seniors, students and academics through appropriate marketing measures
