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

Studying in Passau –What do I have to expect?



- Pro-active students working independently

 - the entire organization of your studies
 - timetable
 - registration for courses and exams
 - for your time management
 - studies
 - household
 - Job
 - leisure time

- Development of career goals



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Curriculum, ECTS credits and Grades



Semester cycle

- Winter term: October 1 –March 31
- Summer term: April 1 –September 30

Lecture period:

- -23 April 2025 -25 July 2025
- -Regular courses

Lecture-free time:

- -Examination period: up to six weeks after the end of lectures
- -Afterwards "holidays"
- -Internships, term papers etc.

ECTS credits and grades



ECTS: European Credit Transfer System

- Awarded in every course of studies (except: Law)
- 1 ECTS credit means a workload of 30 hours
 - 30 ECTS x 30 hsworkload = 900 hs/ semester
 - 900/40 hs= 22,5 weeks of full-time work per semester
- In order to complete you studies in time, you should receive an average of 30 ECTS credits every semester.
- For every passed exam you receive:
 - A grade
 - ECTS credits (independent of the grade)


ECTS credits and grades



The German grading system

- In general: the smaller the number, the better
 - Pass: 1 ("very good") -4 ("sufficient")
 - Fail: 5 ("inadequate")
- Law: the bigger the number, the better
 - Pass:
 - 18 ("very good") 4 ("sufficient")
 - Fail:
 - 3 ("inadequate") -0 ("insufficient")



Standard and maximum period of study



Standard duration, maximum programme duration

Standard duration (Regelstudiendauer):

The amount of time you need to complete your studies in general

Bachelor: 6 semesters

Master: 4 semesters

Maximum duration (Höchststudiendauer):

The amount of time you may need at most to complete your studies,

Bachelor: 8 semesters

Master: 6 semesters

- In some courses there are additional deadlines up to which you have to prove a certain number of ECTS
- Please seek advice in good time, if you will exceed the standard period of study!

Lecture (Vorlesung: V/VL)

- Takes place in lecture hall
- Is mostly given by professors
- Students listen and take notes.
- Questions can be asked.
- No participant restriction and no compulsory attendance
- Type of exam: written exam
- Law: "Basic course"

Basic course (Grundkurs: GK)

- Similar to a lecture
- Introductory event
- Often smaller groups (not: law)
- Possible types of examination: presentation, written exam







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- Tutorial (Tutorium: TU)/ Exercise class (Übung: Ü)
 - Accompanies/supports the lecture or the basic course
 - In many cases students serve as lecturers
 - Exercises and repetition of the material from the lecture
 - Smaller groups
 - (Voluntary) homework with preparation and postprocessing
- Scientific exercise (WissenschaftlicheÜbung: WÜ):

 types are varying, very often based on discussions and exercises,
 structure may resemble to a lecture or a (Pro-) seminar
- Advanced scientific exercise (WissenschaftlicheÜbungfür Fortgeschrittene: WÜF):

prior experience; specific requirements to attend

We strongly recommend that you actively participate in exercise classes!







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Seminar (Seminar: S)

- **Proseminar (Proseminar: PS):** during the first semesters
- Advanced seminar (Hauptseminar: HS): during higher semesters and in Master courses
- Small groups and group work
- _ Limited topics, new topics every semester
- Oral participation, discussions are welcome
- Type of examination: presentation, term paper (possibly written exam in proseminars)
- In addition: Master Class (MC), Oberseminar(OS), ...







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"Kompaktseminar" (KS):

- Free courses from the Center for Careers and Competencies (https://www.uni-passau.de/en/zkk/)
- Examples:
 - · Rhetoric and presentation
 - · Time and self management
 - IT courses (Excel, PowerPoint, Photoshop, ...)
- Block events often on the weekend (1-2 days)
- Small groups
- Registration via Stud.IP
- Registration start:02/04/2025,12 o'clock (first come, first served!)
- From 12 to 17 April, the theme week" First Things First "registration started already.







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Language Courses



Language Centre - Sprachenzentrum

- 15 languages to choose from
- Integrated into many courses of study
- All students can also take language courses voluntarily and for free (1-2 courses simultaneously are manageable)
- Oral participation, homework
- Usually compulsory attendance
- Exam: written exam, possibly oral exam

No prior knowledge: Note the registration dates!

For **English** language courses:

Placement tests are divided into the following three subject areas: Law, Cultural studies & Business and economics

Students of the Faculty of Computer Science and Mathematics or of a Teacher Education Programme should take the **English for Cultural Studies** test.





Exams during your studies

Types of Exams

- "Klausuren": written exams, at the end of the lecture period
- "Referate": oral presentations, during the semester
- "Hausarbeiten": essays/papers, usually but not always written during the semester breaks
 - "MündlichePrüfungen": oral examinations, usually at the end of
- the lecture period
- Period of exams (especially written exams): 2 weeks in advance of the end of the lecture period until 3 weeks after the end of the lecture period.
- You will have to register for every exam!
- Use Campus Porta Ifor registration or to sign off.

Academic Adjustments



Academic adjustments are special dispensations thatcompensate for disadvantages brought about by a candidate's disability or chronic or mental illness, some examples:

- Extra time for oral and written examinations, deadline extensions for term papers, theses and dissertations
- Examination in a separate room with a separate invigilator
- Change of exam type: oral exam instead of written exam or vice versa; individual examination instead of group examination
- Extension of the period of study
- Use of technical aids
- Study assistance in the form of a student assistant (reading texts aloud, taking notes in class, text entry into a computer system)
